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Course Overview

This class is an exploration of Art! Students will be introduced to art production, art history, art criticism and aesthetics. They will experiment with different media and processes from assigned projects. Students will learn how to create and use a sketchbook as a daily warm up. Expectations and Class Routines

Students are expected to come into class prepared to create! At the beginning of each class students will begin with a 10-minute warm up. We will use our sketchbook during this time. During INSTRUCTION students are expect to listen quietly and wait to ask questions at the end of the lesson. Transitioning into STUDIO time should be done swiftly and without classroom disruption. Students will use the remainder of the class to work on the current project. CLEAN UP will be conducted 10 minutes before the end of class. The class should look as good or better than when students entered. Once cleaning is complete, students should sit quietly in their seats until dismissal.

Turning in Assignments and Late Work

Assignments are expected to be turned in on the due date. Each assignment will have a reflection and a rubric that the students will fill in and view. The reflection counts as a quiz grade. Put your name on EVERYTHING. It is your responsibility to make up work that is lost or left out of place.

Late work policy - All assignments must be completed and turned in prior to progress reports and report cards. Any assignment that is not turned in by the 4.5 or 9 week reporting periods will remain a 0% in the gradebook.
