Each student that uses the art room, its tools, and materials during the semester is responsible for its cleanliness. Destructive behavior towards art materials, furniture, or equipment will result in the restriction of their use and the completion of projects with pencil and paper only.

**CELL PHONES** will not be allowed during instruction or creation time in the classroom. In order to photograph student artwork, **CELL PHONES** may be used during the last 10 minutes of class with permission from Ms.Junto. A photography unit using student cell phone cameras will be an exception. No texting or social media activity will be allowed. MCHS' cell phone policy will be strictly followed.

Each unit/module and project will be explained in the classroom and in Canvas (online

learning program). When a project is finished each completed project will be photographed by the student and the photo submitted to a specific project submission page in Art 1's Canvas. Edited cell phone photos and/or art room "loaner camera photos" are acceptable. In addition, students will write a reflection. A quality photo(s) of the artwork must be submitted to Canvas in order to earn a grade.

Projects submitted more than two weeks past their deadline will not be accepted. Points will be deducted for each week the project is late. Students with excused absences or have undertaken an exceptionally elaborate project will be given additional time to complete a late assignment — on a case by case basis after discussion with Ms.Junto and her written approval including a new established date.

# Work expected during absences

If a student is absent for 2 days or more, it is highly recommended a student refers to Canvas and work at home on the assignments posted during the absence.

*Grades are earned, not given!* Grades will be determined based on the student's performance in the following areas: creativity, addressing assignment specifics, craftsmanship, written reflections, research, quizzes, studio maintenance, timely completion of assignments, and warm up activities.

**Grade weight** Projects 60% Quizzes (quiz or small project) 20% Daily Assignments 20% Each art assignment is percentage based with a perfect score equaling 100.

100-90% = A 89-80% = B 79-70% = C 69-65% = D 64% and Below = F

**The Final Exam** will be a digital portfolio called a "Creativity Book" that consists of a collection of projects and written reflections that demonstrate the student's growth and understanding of Art 1 concepts and skills. Students need to contribute to this digital portfolio throughout the semester.

The exam grade is significant and counts 10% of a student's final grade.
