We will be studying the state mandated Standards of Learning for 6th grade math, as well as filling in some gaps that were left through the years. Our quarters are laid out as follows:

Quarter 1: review 5th grade skills, multiplication fact mastery, perfect squares and exponents, order of operations, integers and the coordinate plane.

Quarter 2: integer operations, inequalities, solving equations, decimals

Quarter 3: fractions, fractions/decimals/percents, ratios, measures of central tendency, proportions

Quarter 4: congruence, perimeter and area of squares, rectangles, and triangles,

circumference and area of circles, circle graphs

You will also be able to access my pacing guide for the year and a weekly agenda through Canvas.

Our school's grading scale is weighted as follows: Test/Projects 50%, Quizzes 30%, Classwork/Homework 20%. As you notice, grades are weighted heavily on tests and quizzes. Students are given adequate notice of tests and are expected to study to complete them the best of their ability.
