I'm excited to have you in Algebra 1 this year! <u>This course</u> is designed to prepare you for the Algebra 1 SOL test.

Classroom Values:

Academic Expectations:

Absence: When students are absent it is their responsibility to check the absentee folder upon returning to school to collect any notes or handouts that they missed. <u>Students who are absent receive a grace period equal to the number of days</u> they missed plus one to complete work before it is counted late. For example, a student who misses 2 days of school will have 3 days to complete any missing work before that work is late.

Late Work: All late work will receive a 5 point deduction per day down to 50%. Interim grade reports mark the mid-way point in each quarter. Any late work still missing by interim reports becomes a permanent zero. After interim reports, the cycle starts over, and late work will be accepted until the last day of the quarter.

Canvas: On Canvas students can view our weekly schedule as well as access notes and study materials. Students should check Canvas <u>at least</u> once a week.
