CO-CURRICULAR COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

MARCHING BAND

This class meets during the school day, after school on Tuesdays, for football games, and for competitions and parades. The marching band consists of wind players, colorguard, drumline, and the front ensemble. The marching band competes throughout the region and performs often in the Madison community.

SYMPHONIC BAND AND PERCUSSION CLASS

These classes meet during school and periodically after school for scheduled rehearsals.

Performances occur at school and at the district level. The Symphonic Band class consists of wind players and focuses on wind instrument fundamentals and music. The Percussion Class consists of only percussionists and focuses on percussion fundamentals and percussion ensemble music. These groups combine to perform band concerts during the spring semester at the school and district level.

JAZZ IMPROVISATION

This class meets during the school day and primarily focuses on the fundamental concepts of improvisation and how to build that skillset within the jazz genre. This course is highly recommended for those interested in playing in the Jazz Band.

CONCERT CHOIR

This class meets during the school day and periodically after school for scheduled rehearsals. Performances occur at school and at the district level. Most students in this class start as beginners, so there is no expectation for having prior choir experience.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

JAZZ BAND

This group meets twice per week after school during the spring semester and consists of 8th-12th graders. This group plays music of the jazz genre and performs at school and in the Madison community.

WINTER GUARD

This group meets after school after marching band season ends and consists of 8th-12th graders. This group puts together a performance that focuses around dance and color guard skills and competes throughout the region.

Tri-M is a Music Honors Society that meets during club time. This group mentors younger music students and plans the Awards Banquet at the end of the year.
