# Culpeper Soil and Water Conservation District Scholarship

## Description & Award:

The Culpeper Soil and Water Conservation District awards up to \$4,000 in educational scholarships to students who plan to pursue a career in a conservation-related field. These scholarships are available to eligible students living in the five-county area the Culpeper SWCD serves — Culpeper, Greene, Madison, Orange and Rappahannock

## Eligibility:

Individuals should apply who are full time students enrolled in, or who have applied to, a college undergraduate or graduate program interested in an area of student that supports soil and water conservation, natural resource management, environmental science or a related field.

## Requirements:

Unofficial transcripts will be accepted and applicants may include contact info for references (email preferred) in lieu of official letters.

## Description:

## Requirements:

High school transcript, list of community service, honors & awards, employment or internships, SAT, first page of FAFSA student aid report (SAR), email address of one-to-three people you asked to write recommendations

- **Agnes Cunningham Brown Memorial Scholarship**
  - Community service, academic excellence, financial need and above a 3.0 GPA
- **Bobby Lenn Memorial Scholarship**
  - Financial need, good academic standing, community service or work experience,
- **Culpeper Rotary Foundation Scholarship for Two Year Technical or Trade Degree or Technical School Diploma or Certificate**
  - Financial need & community involvement/volunteering
- **Culpeper Rotary Scholarship for four-year Degree**
  - Financial need, GPA of 2.5 or greater, preferred community involvement
- **Ina Kate Carter Scholarship**
  - Students who have been a varsity athlete, financial need & good academic standing
- **Tom and Dot Hand Endowed Scholarship**
  - Pursuing performing arts at a public college in Virginia, good community standing

  - Pursuing trade or technical education, a 2 or 4-year college
- **The Lane E. Warren Scholarship:**
  - Financial need with community service
- **The Madison County Community Fund Scholarship:**
  - Financial need, good academics & community service

## Requirements:

High school transcript, list of community service, honors & awards, employment or internships, SAT, first page of FAFSA student aid report (SAR), email address of one-to-three people you asked to write recommendations

- **Culpeper Wellness Foundation Health & Wellness Scholarship**
  - Good academic standing, accepted into a health or wellness program at Germanna Community College, good academic standing, community service experience, financial need, displays leadership
- **Martha Mae Giles Scholarship**
  - Plans to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university
- **The St. Luke's Foundation Scholarship Fund**
  - Alumni of a private school, GPA of at least 3.0, community service experience





# The Old Rag Master Naturalists Scholarship

## Description:

The Old Rag Master (ORMN) Chapter of the Virginia Master Naturalists Program are volunteer educators, citizen scientists, and stewards helping Virginia conserve and manage natural resources and public lands. The Old Rag Chapter serves Culpeper, Fauquier, Greene, Madison, Orange and Rappahannock counties.

## Award:

\$1,000

## Eligibility:

ORMN's scholarship is designated for an individual student who is a resident of the ORMN Service Area, and is a high school senior who has applied to a college to pursue a Bachelor's Degree in a STEM program that is related to Wildlife/Natural Resources Conservation/Environmental Studies
