Credits

- 5 total credits required to move on to 10th grade, including 3 "core credits"
- Athletic eligibility
 - -You must pass 3 out of 4 classes the semester prior to be eligible to play
 -Winter sports: January semester change is crucial
 - -You must be enrolled in at least 3 classes

Looking ane Dual Enrollment Classes

- Dually enrolled at MCHS and Germanna Community College
- College credit is through Germanna
 - Transferrable to other community colleges and 4 year schools
- Full weight for GPA calculation
- 3.0 gpa to be eligible
- Student/parent pays out of pocket, however, at a discounted rate (this year's tuition = \$55.25/credit)
- 11th /12th grade DE options: English (11 & 12), US History, Pre Calculus, Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Geology, Teacher for Tomorrow

Advanced Placement Classes

- Colleges want to see you challenge yourself with higher level classes
- Once you sign up, COMMITT!
 - Summer Assignment (required for some)
 - College Level Work
 - AP Exam

• This year, MCPS is covering the cost of AP exams (students must take the AP exam to get the weighted credit for gpa calculation)

•AP courses offered: 12th grade AP Government & other AP opportunities for BRVGS students (AP options also available online via Virtual Virginia)

March course registration is very important!!! Class changes after this point will be at a minimum!

GPA SATs/ACTs Difficulty Level of Classes Extracurricular Activities Volunteer Work

Visits

- College rep. Visits (sign up through Naviance)
- College campus field trips (fall-JMU, spring-TBD)
- Military Recruiters (during lunches and sign ups through Naviance)
- Trades and Industry visits (sign up through Naviance)

PSATs

- Offered once a year in October
- Sign up next year as a 10th grader!
- Consider retaking junior year
- Utilize PSAT scores and collegeboard.org to better study for the SATs

(It is recommended that students then take the SATs once spring of junior year and then many retest fall of senior year depending on how they do the 1st time around)

ASVAB

There is typically a fall and a spring administration


• Only 10th, 11th and 12th can test, look to sign up next year!
